Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Confirm current maintenance inspection prior to use
- 2) Confirm weight of piece to be lifted is within capacity of the fork lift to be used
- 3) Operator to be wearing seat belt if provided by factory
- 4) Clear area of pedestrians and all traffic
- 5) Place lift forks under piece to be relocated
- 6) Ensure load is balanced
- 7) Raise up load in cautious matter
- 8) Secure load on forks for transport
- 9) Keep the load as low as possible while moving
- 10) Transport load to location
- 11) Once load is in place lower the forks slowly until forks are free
- 12) Slowly back the fork lift up until the forks are free of the load
- 13) Park the forklift in a safe place out of the way
- 14) Engage the park brake and turn the forklift off along with the propane

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
