Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Open fuel valve on gas tank. Set throttle lever to "Fast" idle position, set choke to closed position, start engine.
- 2) Open choke slightly to prevent flooding. Move to "Open" or "Run" position when engine is warm
- 3) Smooth out the top of the ground using a wide-toothed rake so it's as smooth as possible
- 4) Place the vibratory plate compactor at one edge of the ground area you want to compact.
- 5) Slowly push the plate compactor forward.
- 6) Repeat until area is compacted
- 7) Turn off machine and ensure it is properly stored.

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
