## **Safe Work Procedure:**

- 1) Perform pre trip inspection and record in daily log
- 2) Start using cold start procedure and three point contact rule for entering machine
- 3) Check back up alarm, all gauges and hydraulics
- 4) Check brakes before proceeding to work area
- 5) Turn on beacon lights
- 6) Inspect work area before starting
- 7) In tight areas of where there is heavy traffic, use a spotter
- 8) Load only what weight the skidsteer can haul
- 9) Transport the load as close to the ground as possible
- 10) Always be aware of other workers in the area
- 11) Park on level ground with the attachments resting on the ground
- 12) Park and secure machine
- 13) Exit using three point contact

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
