Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Fasten seat belt before beginning operation of machine
- 2) Lift plow to “U” position for transport.
- 3) Drive to work site.
- 4) Plan your plowing pattern so that you are driving forward as much as possible
- 5) Drive around worksite and check for hazards and obstacles
- 6) Check for locations to pile the snow
- 7) Drop plow, put vehicle in drive and slowly accelerate to push snow
- 8) Come to a complete stop before shifting from forward to reverse.
- 9) Back drag in necessary areas
- 10) Continue to plow until worksite complete. Lower the blade to the ground and turn the plow control off for safety.
- 11) Lift flow to “U” position before leaving site

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
