Safe Work Procedure:

- 1) Do pre trip inspection including all fluid levels
- 2) Enter using 3 point contact method
- 3) Check gauges and alarms
- 4) Turn on beacon lights
- 5) Use seatbelt
- 6) Do not travel on aggressive angles which can cause rollovers
- 7) Do not exceed towing capacity of tractor
- 8) Allow 5 minute cool down before turning engine off

If an emergency situation occurs while conducting this task, or there is an equipment malfunction, engage the emergency stop and follow the lock out procedure
