## Freezing rain

Freezing rain is a common concern in fall with temperatures often at or below freezing.

### What's the danger?

Freezing rain can cause roads and walkways to be extra slippery.

Additionally, freezing rain can soak through your clothes, causing your body temperature to drop.

### How to protect yourself

#### Driving:

- Verify road conditions by checking local weather and traffic reports
- Slow down and allow a safe distance between you and the vehicle in front of you
- Make sure your headlights, taillights, beacons and windows are clean

#### Slips and falls:

- Always look ahead for slippery ice surfaces
- Wear footwear with rubber soles and attach grips to the bottom if necessary
- Be careful getting in and out of vehicles/equipment or when entering/exiting buildings

#### Working outside:

- Wear warm, waterproof clothes and footwear
- Dress in layers
- Change out of your wet clothes when you get home
